

# iPhone Stripey Sock



Quick and easy knit. Perfect for stash busting those leftover 8-ply yarn. You can easily reduce a number of stitches and rows to custom fit it for your own non-iPhone.



## Yarn

Gather all the 8-ply yarn that you have in colours that you like. I used 7 different colours.

## Needle

US 8 or 5.00mm DPNs (I only used four needles, but you can use five if you like)

## Other tools

Stitch marker, crochet hook for weaving in

## Gauge

20 sts and 25 rows/4 inch or 10cm

## Size (after blocking)

Height: 5.5 inch or 14cm

Width: 2.75 inch or 7cm

Cast on 24 sts. Join in the round, making sure not to twist. Place marker so that you know when you've finished a row.

**Rows 1 - 5:** K2, p2 rib

**Rows 6 - 35:** After this, you basically switch to stockinette stitch (knit every row), changing colours when you like. I changed colours every five rows to get the effect shown in the photos.

**Row 36 (binding off row):** Turn project inside out and do a three needle bind-off. If you don't know how to do it, you can find a really good video at <http://www.knittinghelp.com/videos/casting-off>
